How students can find job in local area?

- Follow adverts on Internet. Ask from friends, acquaintances. Look at official pages of Labour Office and share your ad on Facebook.
- Ask your parents, acquaintances. Contact directly to employers.
- Go to the employers. Be polite and show your willingness, be cooperative.
- Look at advertisements, particularly about your local area.
- Keep an eye on offers on internet, Twitter, FB
- Look at adverts in social media, go to a bar or cafe, go to a shop owner etc
- Go to local government and just ask for job.
- Options are limited for students because you can only work at weekends.
 You may ask from a counsellor, ask from unemployment insurance fund.
 To find job you have to be enterprising and courageous. And your
 previous experiences are useful. Use your school holidays for working.
 Your new contacts and friends may be useful for finding next jobs in the
 future.
- Look at adverts in social media, ask from friends. Just keep your eyes and ears open. Adverts can be displayed on the wall of a local shop or stands.
- Think on what job you want to do, think on your transport options, write your CV and a letter of motivation. Be brave and look for different opportunities.
- Write your CV, apply for a job. Just try and you may get it. Ask for suitable job. Ad yourself in social media, look for offers.
- You can find job reading ads on local stands. Your parents' employers may offer job for you because they know you can be trustworthy and reliable. When parents are good at work children are also trusted.
- Just be active and communicate with many people.
